

Important Dates to Remember

April 1, 2010	*Admission deadline for students residing outside of Canada
April 1	Deadline to submit a Supervisor Approval Form for TESL 42
April 15	*Admission deadline for residents within Canada
April 15	**Deadline to register for courses for international residents
May 8	Spring Graduation, Convocation Hall
May 12	**Deadline to register for courses for students residing in Canada
May 12	Classes begin
May 14	One-half of fees due and payable
May 18	Last day to add/drop class or change from audit to credit to avoid financial penalty. There is a \$30 fee per term for complete cancellation of classes (total of \$60. Note: CERTESL Spring and Summer courses are considered to be “multi-term” by the University of Saskatchewan in that they extend over both terms: spring and summer)
May 18	Last possible date for penalty-free registration in a course
June 18	Deadline to apply for final examination(s)
July 6	Remaining half of fees due and payable
July 15	Last day for changing from credit to audit
July 15	Deadline to cancel a course without academic penalty
August 14	Final Examinations
August 31	Deadline to apply to graduate for Fall Graduation, 2010
August 31	Deadline to apply for deferred examination(s)
September 8	Deadline to apply for supplemental examination(s)
September 11	Deferred examinations
October 16	Supplemental examinations
October 23	Fall Graduation (no ceremony)

Once your application for admission has been accepted, you will be eligible to register for courses using the University of Saskatchewan’s online system known as

PAWS (Personalized Access to Web Services, see page 29). Information on how to access PAWS will be emailed to you in your admission letter.

**** You are strongly encouraged to register in your course(s) by April 15 to ensure that your course materials reach you before the start of classes (May 12). You are reminded that you will need to order your textbooks from the University Bookstore as soon as possible as well (see page 26).**
